



- 2. Mr. Frank Dempster will liaise with teams on all hockey related matters.
- 3. The information desk will be manned: 8am to 10am and 4pm to 6pm every day. Any transport, practice time, meal time, bus schedule matters etc., to be dealt with at the information desk. Practice times to be negotiated with Mr. Dempster.
- 4. Only one delegate per country may attend future Directorate meetings.

6. Following an objection from Poland the dressing rooms will be reconfigured to minimise movement resulting from the Sheffield Arena having only four large fully equipped dressing rooms.

7. Opening Ceremony

One fully dressed player from each non competing squad available at 6.40pm. Instructions will be given to the competing teams prior to ceremony.

8. Start/Finish of Games

The ice will be ready for practice 40 minutes prior to each game. Teams must clear the ice 20 minutes before game time.

Team players will be introduced by name prior to each match. The GBR team will be introduced last.

At the end of games teams must line up on blue line. The Man of the Match is presented and National Anthem of winning team is played, then teams exchange handshakes whilst IIHF Anthem is played.

- 9. BIHA will provide doctor for each match. Teams are responsible for their own hospital expenses.
- 10. Goalkeepers wishing to wear non IIHF face masks must sign the IIHF waiver. Copies attached.
- 11. Teams must adhere to IIHF advertising regulations. Copies attached. No advertising on team strips. Manufacturers logo must be blacked out in accordance with the regulations.
- 12. Schedule of officials for first four games is attached.
 Mr. Lindgren is the IIHF Referee Supervisor. Mr. Toemen is responsible for minor officials. Game supervisors must ensure that advertising regulations are followed.
- 13. Mr. Lindgren will check all goalkeepers' equipment during practices. Games will not be stopped in order to check such equipment. If a goalkeeper's equipment is suspected to be illegal during the course of the game it will be checked at the end of the game and the team/player subject to supplementary discipline.

Other equipment may be checked subject to the usual IIHF regulations.

14. Timekeeping System

Mr. Lindgren will check system and advise teams of any special feature e.g. the clock cannot show 4 minutes. Mr. Lindgren will advise Mr. Subrt as to whether or not the clock and goal light are in a "locked" position.

15. Game Sheets

One hour before each game teams should provide their line ups for the press. Mr. Dempster will provide the format. 15 minutes before start of the game teams must submit their lineups to the officials and sign the game sheets. A photocopy must be sent to the IIHF Head Office.

16. Player Registration

Teams must register a minimum of 15 players and 2 goalkeepers. Additional players up to the IIHF limit may be registered up to 2 hours before each game. A registered player who is injured before the first match only may be substituted.

17. Doping Control

Random tests will be carried out by Dr. Jensen of the IIHF. Mr. Subrt will advise the Directorate of what will happen if a player is found to have taken drugs.

18. The BIHA will provide a full statistical service.

19. Standings

Classification will be in accordance with the IIHF regulations. Copy attached.

20. Discipline

Referee meeting at 9.30 am Saturday morning for all referees. Referees will be instructed to call all games tightly especially during the opening 10 minutes.

Gross misconduct and match penalties will incur an automatic one game suspension and players may be subject to additional discipline.

- 21. The teams agreed to co-operate with the Media Director, Selected players will be interviewed at end of each game.
- 22. Eligibility of the teams will be controlled when the Latvian delegate has arrived.

Minutes of the 1st Meeting of the Directorate, as circulated, were approved. $\hfill \hfill \hfill$

Mr. Subrt welcomed the delegate from Latvia and confirmed:

One delegate per team plus interpreter where necessary One representative from the Organising Committee Only the official delegate has the right to vote.

The Chairman acquainted Latvia with information given at the first meeting.

Poland stated they are now satisfied with their dressing room.

Mr. Subrt stated that all arrangements for the first game were satisfactory, including the opening ceremony and start and finish procedures were good.

The Statistician to record the name of the best player in each game in the statistics.

There were no comments from delegates regarding presentation.

Mr. Subrt repeated that teams go on the ice for warm-up 40 minutes before face-off and leave it 20 minutes before face-off.

Arrangements regarding a Doctor at each game are satisfactory. Costs of hospital treatment are the responsibility of the Nation concerned.

Referee Supervisor Ulf Lindgren stated that he had checked the equipment of:

- SVK Goalkeeper No. 23 - All OK

- GBR 25 - All OK - POL - All OK

JPN will be checked today (Sunday) 1 hour 15 minutes before game. LAT will be checked tomorrow.

Goalkeepers' equipment cannot be checked during a game because it would delay the game too much. If requested, players' sticks can be measured during a game and if illegal his team receives a two minute penalty. If legal, then the team requesting the measurement receives a two minute penalty for delaying the game.

Any question regarding goalkeepers who have signed a waiver regarding non IIHF masks should be raised with Mr. Lindgren.

Doping Control

Dr. Jensen will control and carry out random tests at any time. If a player is tested it is the responsibility of the Team Manager to decide if he continues to play. If the result is not known until after the end of the tournament the offending team loses all points gained in the games in which that player played after being tested. Names will be decided by draw and, if during a game, teams advised after the second period.

Any questions should be directed to Mr. Subrt and he will speak to Dr. Jensen. All agreed to leave the question of random testing to Dr. Jensesn. All understood that if a player is tested, continues to play, is eventually proved positive then the team will lose the points, and the goals for in those games will be deleted.

<u>Statistics</u>

Statistics are being circulated to all teams and the Directorate. Composition of the Directorate and Organising Committee to be included in the final set of statistics. Statistics are to be faxed to the IIHF every day.

Discipline

Mr. Subrt attended a meeting of the Referees yesterday. Teams are reminded that a gross misconduct or match penalty will incur one game suspension. The Directorate will decide if a case is more serious and a suspension may be increased.

Teams are co-operating well with the media and the Organising Committee.

The lists of team names as controlled on Friday were circulated.

GBR - (with corrections to some names) 19 players plus 2 goalkeepers. - vacancies 1 player, 1 goalkeeper.

JPN - 20 plus 3

SVK - 18 plus 2. Vacancies - 2 plus 2.


POL - 20 plus 2. Player listed as jersey No. 17 changed to No. 7. Press to be advised.

Players must keep the same jersey Nos. throughout the tournament.

Mr. Subrt explained the situation regarding Latvia. Some players have old Soviet passports because there is as yet no passpsort regime in Latvia. IIHF has a letter from the Department of Citizenship confirming that they are all citizens of Latvia. This was accepted by the Directorate. Players are aware they cannot play for another country in future.

Mr. Fisher and Mr. Hajdusa controlled the Latvia eligibility forms. All OK - 20 plus 3.

It was agreed that player Bondra was eligible to compete for SVK in this tournament. However, in view of objections raised by Directorate members it was further agreed that by playing in this tournament he was not eligible to play in future IIHF tournaments until the matter has been discussed by Congress.

of the 3rd MEETING OF THE DIRECTORATE held at the Forte Crest Hotel on TUESDAY, 31st AUGUST 1993 at 10.00 a.m.

Mr. Subrt requested that the last sentence of the last paragraph of the previous Minutes be deleted as this Directorate is concerned with this tournament only. Delegates of GBR, POL and LAT were of the opinion that it should stay as it is to avoid setting a precedent.

Page 3, line 4 should read 20 + 3, not 14 + 3 (This has been corrected in the final Minutes).

The Minutes as amended were approved.

Game Supervisors

The Games Supervisors reported on the games so far. Please note that players are not allowed to warm up on the ice during the intervals.

In the game LAT-POL the timekeeper pressed the wrong button causing 23 additional seconds to show on the clock against player Vitolins of LAT. The error was corrected and Mr. Lindgren explained the situation to the teams and referees.

At the end of the game GBR-JPN, in the absence of a recording of the National Anthem of Japan the IIHF march was played. This caused some distress to the team for which the organisers apologised and asked forgiveness.

 $\mbox{Mr.}$ Lindgren stated that he will be instructing the referees to be more strict.

Mr. Dempster asked for clarification of the duties of the Referee Supervisor. Does he control the minor officials? On one occasion Mr. Lindgren entered the timekeepers' box, thus delaying the game. It was explained he intended only to help the timekeepers. The rule has not changed. Mr. Lindgren recommended that timekeepers use a separate sheet of paper to clearly record all instructions from the referee. This can then be shown to him through the plexiglas for agreement or amendment.

Doping Control

Dr. Jensen stated that teams will be informed before the end of the third period which players are to report for testing. No further questions on doping control.

Team collours and referee assignments for the games No. 5,6 7 and 8 were allocated as per attached list.

Thanks were expressed to the Slovakian team for their co-operation with the Polish team regarding the use of their showers.

Teams will nominate their 3 best players at the end of the tournament even though there will be no award.

New Registrations

GBR: None,

SVK: Player SVEHLA. His eligibility was controlled.

LAT: 3 new players. Latvia were asked to prepare a signed declaration regarding their Soviet passport holders.

Some countries requested copies of videos of the games.

Misunderstandings regarding "home team" were corrected. The list headed IIHF is correct.

Poland were not represented as the team had already left Sheffield.

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

The Directorate were reminded to submit nominations for the 3 best players of the whole tournament as well as for the 3 best players of each team to the Directorate at the final meeting. Fair Play statistics to be published.

Frank Dempster is holding all originals of game sheets and eligibility forms. These to be handed to Mr. Subrt before departure. Declaration of Citizenship signed by members of the Slovakian team was handed to Mr. Dempster. Declaration by members of the Latvian team would be handed in after this meeting.

Registration of new players by GBR, one goalkeeper and one forward, was submitted and the eligibility forms controlle by Mr. Subrt and Mr. Hajduga.

Jersey colours and officials for games 9 and 10 were allocated as per the attached list.

A copy of the final statistics will be handed to all teams before departure. These may be handwritten due to lack of time and final printed copies mailed to all teams, Mr. Subrt and the IIHF in Zurich as soon as possible.

Waiver regarding face mask from William O'Connor (GBR) was handed to Frank Dempster to forward to the IIHF.

Game Supervisors' Reports.

Game 6. Complaint about long delays between scoring a goal and the public announcement.

Game 7. Complaint regarding players skating around during player introductions. Teams to be instructed to remain on the blue line.

Game 8. Complaint re too long delay in recommencement of play following a penalty. It was felt that language problems, writing down the information

and requests for explanations were the reasons. Please try to avoid delays. Mr. Subrt thanked all game supervisors.

Departure of Teams:

Poland had already left. One player actually left during their last game. This should not be done. The Doping Control Committee could suspect intent to avoid a test. If the player had been selected, the result could have been recorded as positive and incurred two years suspension.

Departure details of all other teams and officials were confirmed.

Closing Ceremony.

Mr. Wight explained what would happen at the end of the final game. If Latvia win game No 9 the tournament winners will be decided by the final game. A Cup will be presented to the winning team and medals to the winning team and the match officials. Mr. Meredith, and finally Mr. Subrt, will say a few words. The Anthem of the winners will be played at the end of the game and the Anthem of the Tournament winners at the end of the closing ceremony, i.e. if Slovakia win the game, their Anthem will be played twice.

The names of the 3 best players of each team and the 3 best players of the tournament will be recorded but there will be no awards.

To avoid the risk of Aids, health rules in Britain require the ice to be resurfaced when blood is spilt. Rules differ in other countries. Dr. Jensen had undertaken to make recommendations.

Mr. Subrt thanked the British Ice Hockey Association and the organisers for taking on this special tournament and for their hospitality and attention to the wishes of the participants. He also thanked all delegates for their participation and patience.


